
The staff have worked extremely hard over the holidays to make sure their classrooms are top notch and ready for the new term ahead.

## Consent Forms and emergency contacts

It is really important that you return the consent forms ASAP

They include so much information about your child for us from allergies, medication to whether you consent to them using the internet, being photographed and where we can use these images and walks around the local area.

In response to new data protection laws introduced in May 2018 (GDPR) schools need to ensure the information they hold on your child is the most up to date, secure and only what you want us to use. Some information will be passed on and might not be done with parental consent as it is part of normal school practice (e.g. passing information to high school)



## CLASS DOJO

Class dojo is much more than a reward system. We use it to communicate 1:1 to parents, or to the whole class or even the whole school. Please make sure you sign up as soon as possible and check your smart phone notifications to make sure you receive the notifications. Teachers (where possible) operate class dojo from 8am to 6pm, so please be patient if you have sent a message and haven't heard back from them!

### After school clubs

You will be receiving the Autumn term's offering of clubs shortly. Please complete the form and return to the school office or class teacher. We aim for them to start from next week. As always we have managed to keep these a free club, but if some become poorly attended, we may change them part way through the term to ensure we meet the needs of as many children as possible.

### Uniform

The children all look very smart in their new uniforms. Thank you for following our uniform policy. Please can you kindly ensure that all items of uniform have your child's name in them – then we can return them if they are lost or misplaced! In order to keep all children safe, children (boys and girls) must not wear earrings to school on PE days. Please note that only plain stud earrings should be worn for school. Nail varnish should not be worn for school and it is important that long hair is tied back and only school coloured bows where possible please.

### PE Days

All children need to participate fully in all PE lessons. For your information these are the days for your child's allocated PE lessons. On occasion lessons may change so it is important that PE kits are in school every day.
